STATE CRIMINAL ALIEN ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SCAAP)

Background

- The State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) is a formula grant program that provides financial assistance to states and localities for correctional costs incurred for incarcerating "undocumented criminal aliens."
- Title XI, Section 1196 is the governing law for the SCAAP program. Title XI governs all Department of Justice (DOJ) grants, including the JAG grants. The funds by only be used for "detention purposes."
- Annual Schedule:
 - o In approximately March of each year, the Department of Justice (DOJ) notifies jurisdictions that applications materials are due by May. The applications are completed by the FCSO.
 - o Award notification comes in September of each year.
 - o Funds are drawn down and estimated uses are reported in October.
- Since program inception, the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office has received, on average, approximately \$113,003 annually. As with other grant funds, the DOJ reserves the right to audit uses of funds.
- Unspent Funds: Typically, the funds have been appropriated annually and unspent funds have been rolled over by Board action or through the budget process. A history of such Board actions is as follows:
