The bonds are a part of the bi-annual issuance of 2/3rds capacity to provide a consistent funding stream to meet the capital repair and maintenance needs for the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools, Forsyth Technical Community College, Parks & Recreation, and general County projects.
