# RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DONATION OF SURPLUS COUNTY VEHICLES TO THE WINSTON-SALEM/FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.C.G.S. 160A-280 TO REPLACE AGING VEHICLES IN THE SCHOOL SYSTEM'S ACTIVE FLEET (GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS, Forsyth County owns certain motor vehicles, identified in the attached letter and incorporated herein by reference, which are no longer useful to the County and should be declared surplus to the County's needs; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 160A-280 allows counties to donate to another governmental unit any personal property that the Board of County Commissioners deems to be surplus, obsolete, or unused; and

WHEREAS, County staff recommends that the three (3) County vehicles, identified in the attached letter, be declared surplus and be donated to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education, a school administrative unit which is a governmental unit as defined by N.C.G.S. 160A-274(a), to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet; and

WHEREAS, the said vehicles would be donated on the conditions that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education agrees that the vehicles would be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet in Forsyth County and further agrees to waive all rights to make any claims against the County relating to any failure of performance of the said vehicles; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners has caused a public notice of this proposed Resolution to be posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the three (3) motor vehicles, identified in the attached letter from Brent Teague, Schools Assistant Director of Maintenance to Kevin Rogers, County Fleet Manager, which is incorporated herein by reference, are hereby declared to be surplus to the County's needs based upon their age and condition.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the donation pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280 by Forsyth County to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education of the three (3) surplus motor vehicles identified in the attached letter from Brent Teague to Kevin Rogers to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to convey title to the said vehicles by donation to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, on the conditions that said vehicles shall be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet and that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education shall waive all rights to make any claims against Forsyth County relating to any failure of performance of the said donated vehicles, to which they agree by accepting title to the vehicles, all subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, a public notice of this proposed donation was posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation and this Resolution was adopted prior to donating the surplus personal property.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to convey title to the said vehicles by donation to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, on the conditions that said vehicles shall be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet and that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education shall waive all rights to make any claims against Forsyth County relating to any failure of performance of the said donated vehicles, to which they agree by accepting title to the vehicles, all subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, a public notice of this proposed donation was posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation and this Resolution was adopted prior to donating the surplus personal property.
