RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DONATION OF SURPLUS COUNTY VEHICLES TO THE WINSTON-SALEM/FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.C.G.S. 160A-280 TO REPLACE AGING VEHICLES IN THE SCHOOL SYSTEM'S ACTIVE FLEET (GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS, Forsyth County owns certain motor vehicles, identified in the attached letter and incorporated herein by reference, which vehicles are surplus, obsolete, or unused and are therefore no longer useful to the County and should be declared surplus to the County's needs; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 160A-280 allows counties to donate to another governmental unit any personal property that the Board of County Commissioners deems surplus, obsolete, or unused; and

WHEREAS, County staff recommends that the two (2) County vehicles, identified in the attached letter, be declared surplus to the County's needs and be donated to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education, a school administrative unit, which is a governmental unit as defined by N.C.G.S. 160A-274(a), to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet; and

WHEREAS, the said vehicles would be donated on the conditions that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education agrees that the vehicles would be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet in Forsyth County and further agrees to waive all rights to make any claims against the County relating to any failure of performance of the said vehicles; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners has caused a public notice of this proposed Resolution to be posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the motor vehicles, identified in the attached letter from Brent Teague, Schools Assistant Director of Maintenance to Kevin Rogers, Forsyth County Fleet Manager, which is incorporated herein by reference, are hereby declared to be surplus to the County's needs based upon their age and condition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the donation, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, by Forsyth County to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education of the surplus motor vehicles identified in the attached letter from Brent Teague to Kevin Rogers to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet.
