FORSYTH COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS BOARD MEETING

September 21, 2010

The Forsyth County Environmental Affairs Board met on September 21, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in the boardroom of the Environmental Affairs Department, 537 N. Spruce Street, Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

I. Call to Order

Peter DeVries called the meeting to order.

II. Approval of Minutes of June 15, 2010.

Peter DeVries asked if there were any questions concerning the minutes of the last meeting or a motion to approve the minutes. Richard Sieg moved to accept the June minutes. A second was received from Fred Osborne and the minutes were approved unanimously.

III. Amendments to Chapter 3 of the Forsyth County Code.

Peter DeVries opened a public hearing on the changes of the Forsyth County Code. No public comments were received at the hearing. Peter Lloyd presented changes to the Air Quality Code explaining proposed code modifications have no adverse impact on any source located in Forsyth County. New code regulations to the Air Quality Control Technical Code included: 3D Section .0544, Section .1011 and Section .1212. Code revisions modifications included: 3A Section .0106, 3D Section .0400, 3D Section .1205, 3D Section .1400 and 3Q Section .0700. The remaining changes are procedural changes, editorial changes, clarifications, corrections, etc. Peter Lloyd addressed questions from the board re: fugitive dust control plan, air toxic rules, heavy-duty idling restrictions, etc. Mr. Fulp informed the Board that Patrick Reagan will be involved on the idle reduction rule. Tommy Thompson expressed concern about the heavy duty idling rule and suggested the board consider commenting to the Environmental Management Commission. After discussion, Tommy Thompson moved to adopt the code changes. Fred Osborne seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously.

Mr. Fulp informed the Board that our department will be moving to the Government Center in 2011 and will keep the Board posted on the move.

Mr. Fulp recommended to the Board a trip to the Archie Elledge Plant Facility before the end of October.
