A person who has filed a notice of candidacy for a municipal office may withdraw their candidacy at any time, but will only receive a refund of the candidate's filing fee if the withdrawal is prior to the close of business on the third business day on which the right to file for that office expires.  No general election candidate in a partisan contest may withdraw on or after the first day absentee ballots are distributed for the election.
