Approval of Minutes

Pct 201 Update and Options

Brown and Douglas Recreation Center (Pct 201) has structural issues within the building. Mr. Hines was notified by the City of Winston-Salem that an engineer is scheduled to survey the building and after completion, Mr. Hines would be contacted with an update. Several options were presented to the Board if there was a conclusion that the recreation center was deemed unsafe to use as an election day precinct. Secretary Russell moved and Member El-Amin seconded a motion to approve using Option #A2, B1, B2, B3 and B4 (in that order) if there was no contact from the city by 1:00 pm, October 22, 2014. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Approval of Absentee Ballots Returned

Mr. Duffey recommended 581 absentee ballots for approval and 50 absentee ballots for disapproval because of missing information. The voters of the disapproved absentee ballots had been mailed a second ballot and letter of explanation. Member El-Amin moved and Secretary Russell seconded a motion to accept the staff recommendation of 581 absentee ballots for approval and 50 absentee ballots for disapproval. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Other Business

The Board wanted to extend their gratitude to Piney Grove Baptist Church for allowing the potential use of their facilities, fee waived, if Pct 201 is not available.

Member El-Amin moved and Secretary Russell seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting. **Motion carried unanimously** and the meeting was adjourned at 5:35 PM.
