Meeting Called to Order

The Canvas Meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the second floor Board Room on Friday, May 27, 2022 at **11:04** a.m., Chairperson Robert Durrah, Jr. presiding.

Report on Hand-to-Eye Audit

Deputy Director Bobadilla presented to the Board the Hand-to-Eye Audit results for approval. Precinct 123, Forsyth Friends Meeting, and precinct 704, Parkway United Church of Christ, were randomly selected by the State Board of Elections and no discrepancies were found between the hand-to-eye audit count and the DS200 tabulator count from election day. Member Harvey moved to approved the Hand-to-Eye Audit results; Member Doomy seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Report on Audit and Reconciliation

Mr. Clark presented to the Board the Vote Audit and Reconciliation Report. All but two votes from Election Day were accounted for allowing for a 0.01% discrepancy total. The total ATV (Authorization To Vote) Forms were 28,836 and the total reconciled votes were 28,834. Member Doomy moved to approve the Vote Audit and Reconciliation Report; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

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certify the May 17, 2022 Primary Election; Secretary Jourdan seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
