Meeting Called to Order

An absentee meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the second floor Board Room on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at **2:06** p.m., Chairperson Robert Durrah, Jr. presiding.

Pledge of Allegiance

Chairperson Robert Durrah led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Chairperson Robert Durrah led a moment of silence.

Public Comments

Chairperson Robert Durrah called for public comments. None.

Approval of Absentee Ballots

Mrs. Lash presented the Board with 205 total absentee ballots for review; 8 of which are to be disapproved, and of the 197 ballots to be approved 3 are overseas ballots. She also presented to the Board 1 civilian ballot for pending a cure certification. Mrs. Lash informed the Board that all individuals with spoiled ballots have been contacted and notified to vote in-person by today, May 17, 2022.

Member Doomy moved to approve the 194 civilian absentee ballots and 3 overseas ballots and to disapprove 8 ballots; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

One ballot did not scan in the high speed central counter: the ballot was marked spoiled, the board members duplicated the ballot that was spoiled, and the ballot was rescanned through the counter.

Board Members signed absentee voter reports for the approved and disapproved ballots.

Board members signed the Zero Reports for the DS850 high-speed scanner.

Other Business

Director Tim Tsujii provided an update on events of the day: all 108 precincts opened on time. Some parents have expressed concerns about schools being used as voting locations.

Board discussed following up with the School Board regarding election day events and calendar updates.
