## FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS Meeting Minutes May 3, 2022 – 5:00 p.m.

#### Meeting Called to Order

## **Approval of Meeting Minutes**

## **Approval of Absentee Ballots**

Louise Lash, Absentee Voting Manager, presented the Board with 169 total absentee ballots for review and 14 ballots to be disapproved. Of the 169 ballots to approve, 1 was an overseas ballot. Mrs. Lash informed the Board that voters who mailed their ballots in envelopes that were taped were all contacted. Each voter confirmed that they placed the tape on the envelope to make sure the ballot was secure when mailing.

32 ballots did not scan in the high speed central counter due to tears and folds: all 32 were marked spoiled; the board members duplicated the 32 ballots that were spoiled and those were scanned through the high speed central counter.

Member Doomy moved to approve the 169 approved ballots which included 1 overseas ballot and to disapprove 14 ballots; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.** 

Board Members signed absentee voter reports for the approved and disapproved ballots.

Board members signed the Zero Reports for the DS850 high-speed scanner.
