Director's Report included

- Approaching 16 thousand cases in Adult Division, an increase of approximately 23,000 since June 2009
- Food and Nutrition cases are totaling over 20,500
- Family & Children's Medicaid are totaling 27,000
- Work First Cash Assistance clients total 925 for June
- Beacon
 - o is currently working on scanning the 2 million pieces of paper
 - The projected test date is August 5
 - Full implementation is projected for October 4
 - The Director will send email progress reports to Board during implementation
- The NC Appellate Court struck down the Responsible Individual's List. The Legislature is crafting language towards the attempt to reinstate the List.
- The Nurse Family Partnership will meet at DSS on August 11 co-hosted by Forsyth Futures
- DSS Human Resource calculates the lack of capacity due to unfilled positions for last year equated to approximately 11,000 hours.
- The departure rate was around 10% for that same time period.

- FMLA continues to pose challenges.
- DSS has 10 days to take possession of unclaimed bodies from the hospital
