The Director's Report included:

- Brief on 2/9 to the County Commissioners which included workload expansion
- Letter sent to Forsyth Delegation in support of the position statement articulated by the North Carolina Association of Boards of Social Services regarding SB 433
- o Child Care Program will soon have a zero total waiting list
- Discussion on whether to invite representatives from Smart Start, Family Services and the Winston-Salem Journal to the March meeting for a daycare conversation

#### Consent

#### Strategic

Medicaid Transportation program updates included:

- Call Center is receiving 140 calls daily
- Pat Read explained the "trip" process and record documentation
- WSTA coordinates approximately 3 thousand trips monthly and are collaborating with DSS to officially partner effective April 1, 2012.

Food and Nutrition

• The State projects a 15% statewide county error rate

#### FAMIS

- There will be a conference call to set a final plan to complete the F&N module
- Forsyth County has paid approximately 50 65% of the contract to date
- Implementation of NC Fast is projected for September 1; if the schedule holds

Increase in County Dollars

- New Position Request \$116,624
- Increase in County Benefit Costs \$40,226
- Decrease in TANF revenues of \$399,645
- Decrease in Adoption Assistance Revenues \$130,000 inaccurate estimates previous year
- Increase \$30,000 Temp Help Expense
- Increase of \$25,000 in Small Equipment Expenditures to meet needs of State's NCFAST initiative
- Decrease of \$132,000 in DoD Contingency FNS Funding revenues

# Decrease in County Dollars

- Increase in Enhanced Medicaid Interpretation revenues of \$60,000
- Increase of \$148,250 in FFP revenues related to Imaging and Automation
- Decrease in County Longevity Pay \$72,000
- Decrease in County Foster Care expenditures \$90,000
- Increase in Child Support Enforcement Incentive revenues \$49,000
- Increase in Medicaid Transportation Administration revenues \$80,000
- Increase Adult Day Care revenues \$40,000
