Family & Children's Services has been meeting with hospitals in an effort to build relationships. The Agency successfully met and surpassed the 90% mark for foster home visits and achieved 96.2%.

The agency signed a contract with Beacon Analytics to continue to use FAMIS until NCFast is operational at a level to sustain the work of the Agency's Food and Nutrition department. It is believed that accessing external information sources adds to the inefficiency of the NCFAST design.

Funds for the 2012 Crisis Intervention Program have been exhausted.
