Information

Bobbi Bales, Program Manager in TEAM Division, introduced Clem Withers to the Board and announced his retirement effective August 1 after 30 years of service.

The Director introduced Carmelita Burrell as the Employee of the Year for 2008 – 2009 and reminded them of her exemplary work with young people in the DSS foster care program, the Youth In Transition program, and the Teens Engaged in Aspiring Mentorships – an Uplifting Partnership (TEAM UP) project.

The Director informed the board of the impending budget change involving the elimination of level 3 and 4 youth placements in the Therapeutic Foster Care Plan. He mentioned the Vacancy Review Process and, passed out the LBR report to be discussed in detail at the August board meeting

Only 12 of the 20 vacancies throughout the agency have been requested to fill. DSS has not filled a position since April except with Stimulus money. Mr. Plyler said he will meet with County Manager today to discuss DSS vacancies.
