The Director's Board Policy Compliance Report informed that:

- Significant increase in **Day Care Subsidy** services due to one time stimulus funds will take place in this fiscal year.
- Work First will undergo a major policy change in October 2009 when the state mandates all counties move to "pay after performance"
- Elimination and/or reduction in Level III and IV residential placements for youth will cause substantial changes in philosophy and current services for these youth. The premise is these youth can be as effectively served in local communities through therapeutic foster services and wrap around community services.

The Director reported that the Benchmarks continue to be reviewed and that division directors will report on new benchmarks during the October board meeting.

Strategic

The Director reported the stimulus positions have not been filled. The board discussed the length of time that it takes to fill open positions.
